





"CONSULTATION WORKSHOP ON DRAFT FACULTY NORMS AND REGULATION (DIPLOMA AND DEGREE) AICTE"

The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has established regulations aimed at standardizing the appointment, pay, promotion, career advancement, and service conditions of faculty members at AICTE-approved technical institutions. These regulations are periodically reviewed to ensure they remain relevant and aligned with current educational needs.

A consultation workshop on these norms was scheduled to be held at AICTE Headquarters, Nelson Mandela Marg, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi, on September 18, 2024, at 10:30 A.M.. This workshop specifically focused on reviewing norms for Degree and Diploma programs, providing a platform for discussion and feedback regarding faculty standards and other institutional regulations.
